ITB Clause no. 15.4 (h) (Price schedule) and ITB clause no. 30.1 (Commercial evaluation) states that " The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all duties, taxes and other levies except GST" Whereas, in 'Clause no. 14.1(Taxes and Duties), Section-IV, General Conditions it is stated that " The quoted bid price (both supply and service portion) shall include all taxes and duties etc."	Kindly appreciate that all the taxes and duties e.g. GST, BoCW and import duty may please be excluded from quoted price and should be shown separately to ensure all bidders are considering the same taxes and duties. This schedule was also available in your earlier tender no. 'SJVN/CHQ/ECD/LHEP-I/EM/20' for EM works for Luhri-I HEP 210(2X80+2X25) MW as 'Schedule no. 5: Taxes and duties'. We request you to please add this additional schedule for taxes and duties in the given price schedule. Accordingly, ITB clause no. 15.4 (h) (Price schedule) and ITB clause no. 30.1 (Commercial evaluation) of Sunni Dam may please be modified inline with same clause of Luhri-I HEP. Above changes are also required inline with 'Clause no. 14.1(Taxes and Duties), Section-IV, General Conditions' to adjust the change of law regulations regarding taxes required in future. We have raised this query earlier also vide our letter reference no. VH-BC Bid -1053-LF -PBQ/3 dated 14.02.2025.
