

## TReDS

TReDS is an electronic platform for facilitating the financing / discounting of trade receivables of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) through multiple financiers. MSMEs, despite their important role in contributing to the Indian economy, continue to face constraints in obtaining adequate finance. One big factor which affects the ability of MSMEs to convert trade receivables into liquid funds are slow paying invoices. To address the financing related issues faced by MSMEs in India, RBI in 2014 introduced the concept of TReDS, a mechanism of trade receivables financing for MSMEs on a secure digital platform.

As per the Govt. Notifications dated 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2018 all companies registered with the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013) with a turnover of more than Rs.500 crore (Rupees Five Hundred Crore) and all Central Public Sector Enterprises shall be required to get themselves onboarded on the Trade Receivables Discounting System Platform, set up as per the notification of the Reserve Bank on India.

Under the Directions of Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises, SJVN Limited registered on TReDS portal on 30.11.2018.
