

The Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India has accorded Environment Clearance (EC) for construction of 66 MW Dhaulasidh Hydro Electric Project vide their letter no. J-12011/15/2010-IA-1 dated 21/02/2013 (Annexure-I). A small River shaped reservoir will be formed and its area would be about 713 ha.

River valley projects interfere with the riverine ecosystem by way of reduced water quantum, heavy loads of silt and changed water chemistry which in turn affects the fish and the fisheries wealth in the concerned river. Not only this dams act as physical barriers to breeding and feeding runs of the fish. This results in irrevocable reduction of fish fauna, ranging from reduced level of abundance to complete extermination.

3.0 Objectives:

To mitigate the effect of construction of the Dhaulasidh H.E. Project on fisheries wealth of the Beas River, this project has been proposed with following board objectives:

- ❖ To develop sustainable fisheries in Dhaulasidh reservoir.
- ❖ Adequate replenishment of Riverine fish fauna by producing and stocking their seed to offset the loss of auto breeding/auto stocking besides losses due to degradation of aquatic eco-system.

The reservoir is not amenable to culture practice and can only yield capture fishery. Since reservoir fisheries are stock and take type hence stocking is an important tool in management of fishery. In the Dhaulasidh reservoir supplementary stocking programmes are proposed. To achieve these objectives facilities to produce seed of carp fish have to be strengthened and expanded. There are Govt. hatcheries in the state which needs repairing and modification to run smoothly. Work like repairing of hatchery of Mahaseer fish farm Machhial and stocking of Mahaseer fish seed by purchase for consecutive three years for stocking in newly created reservoir is proposed in order to harness the fisheries potential in the public interest of the state in order to create self employment to fishermen and to get protein rich food in the form of fishes from the proposed reservoir.

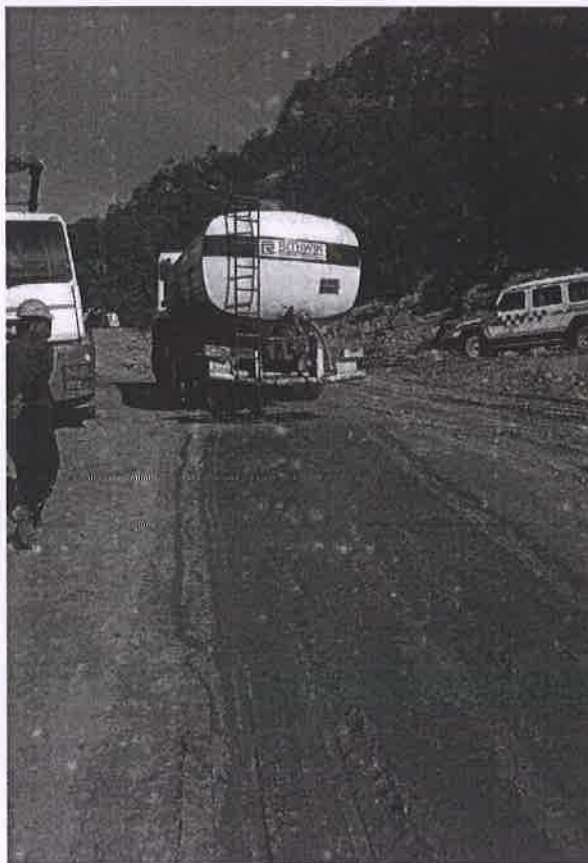

- The first meeting of Multi-Disciplinary Committee constituted by the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, New Delhi in compliance of condition stipulated in environmental clearance of Dhulasidh hydroelectric project was held on 18.01.23 at Project Site.
- At the outset Sh. Parminder Kumar, AGM (HoP), Dhulasidh HEP welcome all members of Multi-Disciplinary Committee. Thereafter, HoP explained the salient features of the project. He briefed that Dhulasidh Hydro Electric Project is a run-of-river scheme with Dam toe powerhouse. The project envisage construction of 50m high Concrete gravity Dam above river bed level across the river Beas to generate 66 MW of Hydropower. The committee was apprised with progress made in various



components of the project. At present, Diversion tunnel had been completed and the River has been diverted on 15.02.2022 by constructing Concrete Cofferdam. The excavation work of powerhouse, left bank has been completed and excavation of right and Dam foundation is in progress.

- Thereafter, Sh. Parminder Kumar, Member Secretary, apprised the Committee about the progress on implementation of Environment Management Plan of the project by power point presentation. Out of approved EMP cost for Rs. 34.147 Cr., about Rs. 28.20 Cr. has been deposited with other nodal departments for execution of EMP works. It is pertinent to mention here that the updated CAT plan amount of Rs. 19.77 Cr. is included in the deposited amount of Rs. 28.20 Cr.
- The point - wise progress made on the EMP activities so far as follows:

1. Implementation of Catchment Area Treatment Plan (CAT Plan)

- SJVN informed that the updated CAT Plan amount of Rs. 19.77 Cr. against Rs. 10.95 Cr. was deposited with CAMPA on 09.10.2019. In this regard, Chairman enquired about the current status of CAT Plan implementation and desired to present details of implementation along with breakup of physical and financial progress in next MDC meeting.

(Action by - Concerned DFOs)

2. Implementation of works under Compensatory Afforestation and NPV

- SJVN appraised that required amount towards Compensatory Afforestation and NPV Rs. 7.05 Cr. was deposited with CAMPA on 09.10.2019. In this regard, Chairman enquired about the current status of CAT Plan implementation and desired to present details of implementation along with breakup of physical and financial progress in next MDC meeting.

(Action by - Concerned DFOs)

3. Muck dumping activities

- SJVN informed that 3 no. dumping sites have been designated for dumping of muck to be generated from project activities. Out of total 0.588 Mm³ muck generated,



around 0.078 M m³ has been reutilized for development of roads and facility areas. The remaining 0.510 Mm³ muck has been dumped in the designated dumping sites.

- SJVN apprised that engineering measures are being provided in dumping area to avoid spillage into the river/Nallah. It was also apprised that after closure of dumping sites, turfing of slope will be done using Geotextile blankets.
- Chairman & Committee members desired strict implementation of muck dumping plan in project site as per approved muck management plan. Further, members suggested that retaining wall of stone masonry with plum concrete may be explored by Project in Dumping areas.
- Further Member Wildlife suggested for plantation of local species at muck dumping sites for slope stability and erosion control.

(Action by – Project)

4. Fisheries Management Plan

- SJVN further informed the committee that a provision of 05 Million has been kept in Approved Environment plan for fisheries Management. It was informed by representatives of Fisheries department that updated fisheries management plan has been submitted to Competent Authority for approval.
- Chairman desired that the detailed fish management plan may be shared by Fisheries Department in next MDC.

(Action by – Fisheries Department)

5. Biodiversity Conservation and Management Plan

- SJVN informed that a budget of Rs.10.65 Million has been kept under Biodiversity Conservation Plan for development of herbal nursery and anti-poaching activities near Sanotu Village. It was also informed that an amount of Rs. 44.54 Million for afforestation and 19.7 Million for wildlife improvement and development has been kept in CAT plan.
- Chairman desired that project may explore the possibility of development of herbal nursery in consultation with Forest Department



- Member Wildlife suggested fencing of dam site/project area along with provision of safe passage for wild animal, if any.

(Action by – Project/Forest)

6. Environment Monitoring

- Committee was informed that Environment parameters such as Monitoring of Air, Water and Noise are being carried out by HP Pollution Control Board, Una & IDMA Laboratories Limited and all parameters are within permissible limits.
- Chairman and Members desired for more frequent sprinkling of water of roads for dust control. Further monitoring of air, water and noise parameters be done regularly preferably by installing instrument/ machinery at project site as the construction work is in full swing.




Labour Camps:

Appendix-A

Various components of the **Biodiversity Conservation and Management Plan** of the EIA/EMP report are being implemented as the project is being executed. The details are as under:

1. It is being ensured that noise levels don't go beyond 100dB(A), as can be seen in monitoring reports submitted with six-monthly compliance reports. This is being done by:
 - a. Regular maintenance of vehicles
 - b. Housing equipment permanently located at a site in noise absorbing structures
 - c. Mounting the vibratory equipment on anti-vibration mountings
 - d. Fitting silencers on machines with combustion engines, etc.
2. It has been proposed to develop a **Herbal Nursery near Village Sanotu** over an area of 0.50 ha. The issue has been taken up in the MDC meeting dated 18.01.2023 and the Chairman desired that project may explore possibility of development of herbal nursery in consultation with HPFD. Currently, the said land is being identified by HPFD.
3. It was also informed that an amount of Rs. 44.54 Million for afforestation and 19.7 Million for wildlife improvement and development has been kept in CAT plan.
4. Anti-poaching measures: fencing has been provided along the way to the dam site.



In addition, following activities and safeguards are being undertaken:

- a. Labor colonies are set up away from forest area/wilderness
- b. To minimize the pressure on forests and animal habitats for fuel,
 - i. Community kitchen has been made functional
 - ii. Cost for constructing 10 crematoria has been deposited

- iii. LPG connections, solar emergency lights, solar cookers and solar water geysers have been provided for.
- c. Movements and activities of laborers and associated workers is monitored to avoid disturbance in habitat of wild animals and birds.

The cost of Compensatory Afforestation and NPV, amounting to Rs.7.05 Cr. has already been deposited with CAMPA on 09.10.2019, prior to issuance of Stage-II Forest clearance.
